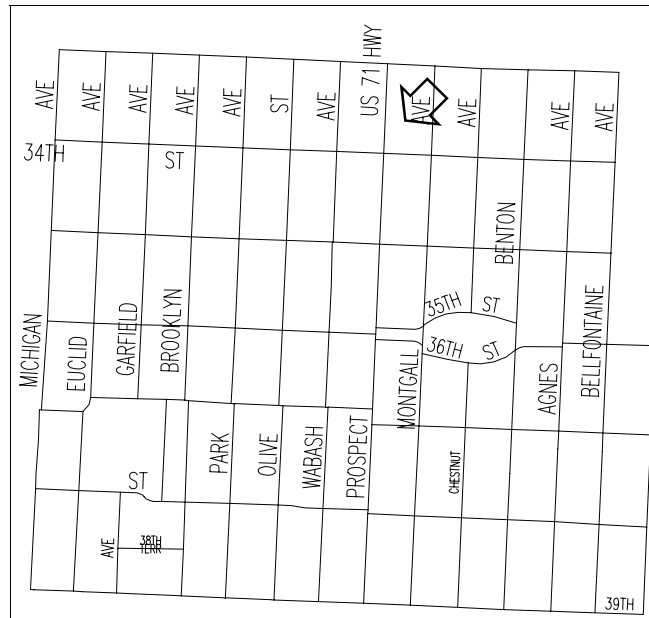


# Palestine Senior Citizen Activity Center

The 35,000 square foot Palestine Senior Citizen Activity Center was constructed in 1992 to assist the physical, social and economic well-being of elderly adults.
