#### **Program Objectives:**

1. Discuss current issues surrounding tuberculosis in correctional facilities including incidence and risk factors
2. Implement measures to decrease the risk of tuberculosis transmission in correctional facilities
3. Develop an organizational plan for conducting tuberculosis contact investigations and management of tuberculosis cases
