

**ARRA April 10, 2010 Quarterly Summary Report
Indian Creek Trail – Parks and Recreation Department**

On May 11, 2009 Kansas City Park Recreation Department had been selected for Transportation Enhancement Program funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act to receive up to \$365,000.00 in Grant Funding. The Missouri Department of Transportation (MODOT) has assigned ARRA-ES04(024) as the federal project number.

1. Indian Creek Trail (Lydia to UP) - \$255,245.00 Mega Construction Bid Amount

ARRA funds will be used to construct pedestrian walking trail for approximately 2,300 linear feet along the Indian Creek Greenway under the authority of the Kansas City Parks and Recreation Department. The area is used as a pedestrian trail for walkers and bicyclist for access to neighborhoods, businesses, schools and recreational areas. This section of trail connects: Missouri to Kansas, Five cities, two counties, and several miles of trail.

Project scope includes 10 wide hard surface trail and limestone retaining walls along the Indian Creek Greenway from Lydia Avenue east to the Union Pacific Railroad Right-of-Way. The project bid January 27, 2010 with Mega Construction submitting the low bid at \$255,245.00 and DBE participation of 6%. Construction should begin in May and construction and final completion by September 2010.
