#### Project name:

Civil Works Program - Turkey Creek



#### **Description:**

Flood risk management of the flooding that occurs as a result of overflow from the Turkey Creek channel and runoff from the adjacent hillsides. Current depth of flooding along Southwest Blvd is 10 feet for the 25-year event, and flooding of Interstate 35 has occurred twice in the past decade. The Turkey Creek project is a bi-state flood risk management project providing benefits in both Kansas City, Missouri and the Unified Government of Wyandotte County.





# Significant Progress this Quarter

Original authorized ARRA funding of \$13,500,000 has been reduced to \$12,100,000 due to lower than expected contract costs. Walled channel construction was awarded with \$10,704,706 ARRA funding on 6/8/2010. The remaining funds have been obligated on design modifications and administration of the contract. Construction on the walled channel was completed December 2011. Final O&M manual in progress. Final payment scheduled for April 2012.
