Primary purpose/description of this program: The construction of the north roundabout and on / off ramp at Briarcliff Parkway / Missouri 9 Hwy Interchange, utility relocations within the area including the Missouri Gas Energy transmission line and the construction of traffic signal at N. Mulberry Drive & Briarcliff Parkway and all necessary turn lanes.	
Federal Funding through ARRA: \$2,500,000 in federal funding through ARRA.	
Other funding sources / Local Match needed?: MoDOT - contributing \$3,500,000 towards the interchange improvement (south roundabout). Briarcliff Development Company contributing \$3,500,000 towards the interchange improvement south roundabout)

Funding Period: Design is being completed and plans will be submitted to MoDOT on June 12, 2009 for bidding. MoDOT anticipates the project being under construction in October 2009. Construction is anticipated to be completed by summer 2010.	
Services provided to the public: Improved traffic flow and safety.
