<p>Other funding sources / Local Match needed?: No match is required in this program but the City will ask that subgrantee's leverage the project and city staff shall seek resources to help the subgrantee's address participant needs not covered by the grant.</p>	
<p>Administrative Costs and Eligibility for covering those costs: Administrative cost reimbursement is capped at 5% of the total awarded and it is strongly recommended that the grantee share with subgrantee's.</p>	
<p>Funding Period: 3 years- October 1, 2009 thru September 30, 2012 Note: 60 percent of the funds must be spent by September 30, 2011. 100% expended by September 30, 2012.</p>
