

ARRA October 2009 Summary Report
Indian Creek Trail – Parks and Recreation Department

On May 11, 2009 Kansas City Park Recreation Department had been selected for Transportation Enhancement Program funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. The Missouri Department of Transportation (MODOT) has assigned ARRA-ES04(024) as the federal project number.

1. Indian Creek Trail (Lydia to UP) - \$365,000.00.

ARRA funds will be used to construct pedestrian walking trail for approximately 2,300 linear feet along the Indian Creek Greenway under the authority of the Kansas City Parks and Recreation Department. The area is used as a pedestrian trail for walkers and bicyclist for access to neighborhoods, businesses, schools and recreational areas. This section of trail connects: Missouri to Kansas, Five cities, two counties, and several miles of trail. This project's plans are currently being reviewed by the Missouri Department of Transportation and plan to have MoDOT obligate the funds by the December 1, 2010 deadline.
