The <b>Airfield Pavement Repairs – Phase 2</b> project will provide for the removal and replacement of pavement sections on runways 1R-19L &amp; 9-27 and the terminal aprons to include joint seal removal and replacement and pavement markings removal and replacement as required to meet new FAA pavement marking requirements.</p>	
<p><b>Federal Funding through ARRA: \$7,000,000</b> The Project is currently programmed by the FAA to receive \$7,000,000. The actual grant amount will be determined based upon the bid and actual construction contract award.</p> <p><b>Other funding sources / Local Match needed?: NONE</b> This grant will be a 100% reimbursement grant with no local match required.</p>
