<b>Expected Outcomes of Program / Project:</b> The proposed projects will install traffic signal mast arms at all intersections. We anticipate great accident reduction because visibility of the traffic lights will be improved. Project will also install pedestrian signal heads and buttons to provide safer pedestrian crossings. Project will be integrated with Operation Green Light which is a metro-wide program to synchronize traffic signals so that drivers can travel along thoroughfares without having to stop at red lights.
