<b>Primary purpose/description of this program:</b> Turkey Creek improvements	
<b>Federal Funding through ARRA:</b> \$13,500,000 for walled channel construction and replacement of existing railroad bridge.  <b>Other funding sources / Local Match needed?:</b> Project is 65% federally funded with 35% local sponsor match. The City has partnered with the Unified Government of Wyandotte County and Kansas City, Kansas as the local sponsors for this project.	
<b>Administrative Costs and Eligibility for covering those costs:</b> None	
<b>Funding Period:</b> Turkey Creek funds have been obligated for the walled channel work.	
<b>Services provided to the public:</b> Flood risk management of the flooding that occurs as a result of overflow from the Turkey Creek channel and runoff from the adjacent hillsides. Current depth of flooding along Southwest Blvd is 10 feet for the 25-year event, and flooding of Interstate 35 has occurred twice in the past decade.	
<b>Essential services this program fulfills:</b> Flood risk management.
