Turkey Creek	\$ 13,500,000.00	\$ 22,000.00

Flood risk management of the flooding that occurs as a result of overflow from the Turkey Creek channel and runoff from the adjacent hillsides. Current depth of flooding along Southwest Blvd is 10 feet for the 25-year event, and flooding of Interstate 35 has occurred twice in the past decade. The Turkey Creek project is a bi-state flood damage reduction project providing benefits in both Kansas City, Missouri and the Unified Government of Wyandotte County and Kansas City, Kansas.

Project Status: Walled channel construction expected to be awarded first half of 2010 with ARRA funding. Purchase of steel to replace an existing railroad bridge is expected Fall 2010.
