Subject: New Fees for Banner Permits, Encroachments in City Right-of-way and Vacation of Easements.

On October 10, 2002, the Third Committee Substitute for Ordinance No. 020878 was passed by the Council of Kansas City. This ordinance will take effect 30 days after passage. The effective date will be November 12, 2002 because of the recognition of Veteran's Day on November 11.

Beginning November 12, all new applications and renewal applications for permits for Banners in the City Right-of-way will require an application fee of \$50.00, a restoration fee of \$50.00 per City Light-pole used, and an inspection fee which varies depending on the length of the permit and number of poles used.

All other types of encroachment into the City Right-of-way shall require an application fee of \$150.00 and a license fee calculated by the potential value of the Right-of-way being encroached upon.

The ordinance also provides for fees for vacating easements and fees for establishing or changing grades.

New application forms are being prepared along with the procedure, process and required documents for each of the above. Applications forms and procedures are available from the Supervisor of Right-of-way Services, 414 East 12th Street, 18th Floor, Kansas City, Missouri 64106, after October 28, 2002.
