AS-BUILT DRAWINGS FOR SEWERS BUILT BY PERMIT

Section. 30.4 of the Code of General Ordinances requires that as-built drawings be furnished by the permittee before a sewer permit is accepted.

As-built drawings are considered part of the permit work and are the responsibility of the permittee. The cost of furnishing the drawings should be considered when contracting for permit work. The cost of furnishing as-built drawings shall be included in the performance bond.

Requirements for as-built drawings are contained in "CRITERIA FOR PREPARATION OF PLANS FOR STREET PROJECTS , STORM AND SANITARY SEWER PROJECTS" adopted by the City Engineer February 19, 1986.

Sewer inspector's notebooks are no longer furnished by the city. Information needed for the preparation of as-built drawings is the responsibility of the permittee.
