The scheduled payments of principal and interest on the Bonds are insured by Ambac Assurance (“**Bond Insurer**”). Standard and Poor’s Ratings Service released a report on June 24, 2009 downgrading its rating on the Bond Insurer from “A” to “BBB,” which might have had the effect of lowering the long-term rating on some of the Bonds by Standard and Poor’s to either “BBB” or their underlying rating (see Attachment III).
