Subject: **Kansas City Health Department Discontinues Entry of Immunization Records into Statewide Registry**

The Kansas City Health Department has currently discontinued entering immunization records into the statewide registry (MOHSAIC). These are the shot records for children seen at the Kansas City Health Department's 2400 Troost Avenue site. Due to a change in computer software and changes at the state involving a redesign of the state immunization registry, the records of immunizations administered from January 2009 to the present may not be complete. The Kansas City Health Department understands your need for accurate records. These records may be obtained free of charge by a parent or guardian by visiting the 2400 Troost Avenue office. Additionally, other arrangements such as faxing shot records may be available to your office.

Within the next few months we hope to resolve the delay in uploading these records into the statewide immunization registry.
