To be eligible for consideration for employment with the City of Kansas City, MO, you must possess a valid certification with one of the following: American Red Cross Lifeguard, Star Guard or a YMCA Lifeguard certificate. These lifeguard positions are **only** available in at Gregg-Klice, Tony Aguirre or Southeast Community Centers, no outdoor pool positions are available.

**Life Guard**

The American Red Cross Lifeguard Training course provides professional training for individuals 16 years or older, who wish to become a lifeguard. The course is 28 hours in length and participants must attend all classes, participants must pass a swimming pre-requisite, before being admitted into the class: (1) swim 300 yards continuously, using both the front crawl and breaststroke; (2) within 1 minute, 40 seconds swim 20 yards, surface dive 7 - 10 ft., retrieve a 10 lb object, return to the surface with the object, swim 20 yards with the object out of the water, and exit without using a ladder or step.
