RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Board, which, under Missouri law, has the sole duty and responsibility to administer the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department, that statements have been made that certain of the officers of the Department may be in violation of its policies requiring their bona fide residence within the city limits of Kansas City, Missouri; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to restate the long-standing policy of this Board and previous Boards of Police Commissioners, consistent with the applicable laws of the State of Missouri;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Police Commissioners hereby expresses its policy that so long as the applicable statutes of Missouri require that officers of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department shall become bona fide residents of Kansas City, Missouri at or prior to the completion of their probationary period with the Kansas City Police Department, all officers of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department shall be and remain bona fide residents of Kansas City, Missouri during the term of their employment by the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the Kansas City, Missouri Police Department is directed to take such action as shall be appropriate to enforce the above-stated policy of the Board, consistent with the laws of the State of Missouri.
