

FAQ's for East Patrol Site – East Property Crimes Section

1) What should I do if my credit cards that were stolen (Stealing, Burglary) have been used?

A: Any use of stolen credit cards, debit cards, or ATM cards should be reported to the police department in the city where they were used. Each time a credit device is used, a new crime has been committed. You should also make sure that you report your stolen credit devices to the company or bank that issued them.

2) What should I do if I find more of my belongings missing after I have already made a police report?

A: If you need to report additional items stolen, you may go to any KCPD location and complete a Supplemental Property Loss form. In doing this, we are better able to find and return your items when they are located.

3) What should I do if I have additional information that needs to be added to my report, such as suspects, witnesses?

A: Please contact East Property Crimes Section directly with this information so that we may add to your original case. Any information regarding a crime is useful.

4) How long does it take to get results from DNA or fingerprints that were collected at the time of my report?

A: Unfortunately, there is not a set time when we receive the results of the tests. However, if the results come back with a match you will be contacted about your case by a detective.

5) What should I do if I find out where my items that were stolen are?

A: Contact East Property Crimes Section immediately. The better notice that we get the better able we will be to help you.

6) What should I do if I have information regarding a property crime where I was not a victim?

A: If you are willing to participate in prosecution please contact our office directly. Otherwise, we request that you use (816)474-TIPS.
