## LESSONS LEARNED FROM OPEN HOUSES

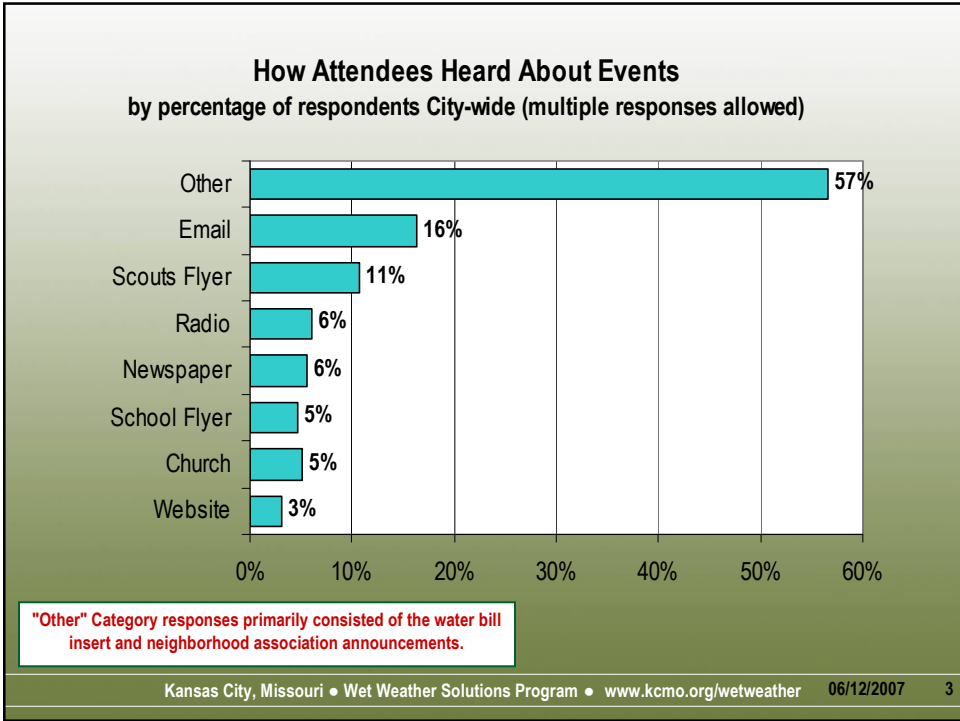
- *Over 400 attendees*

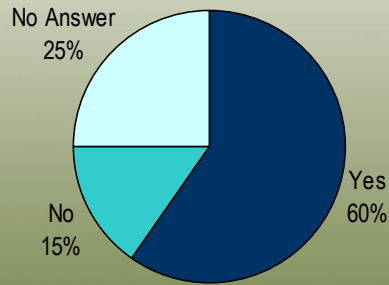

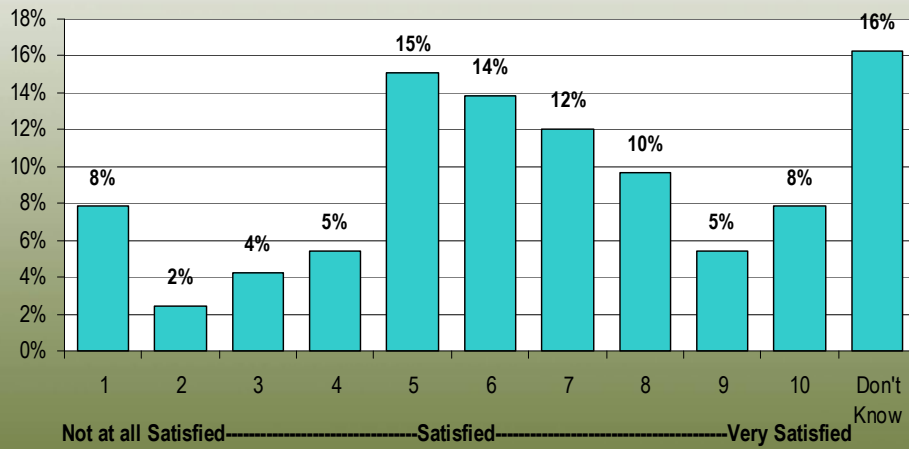

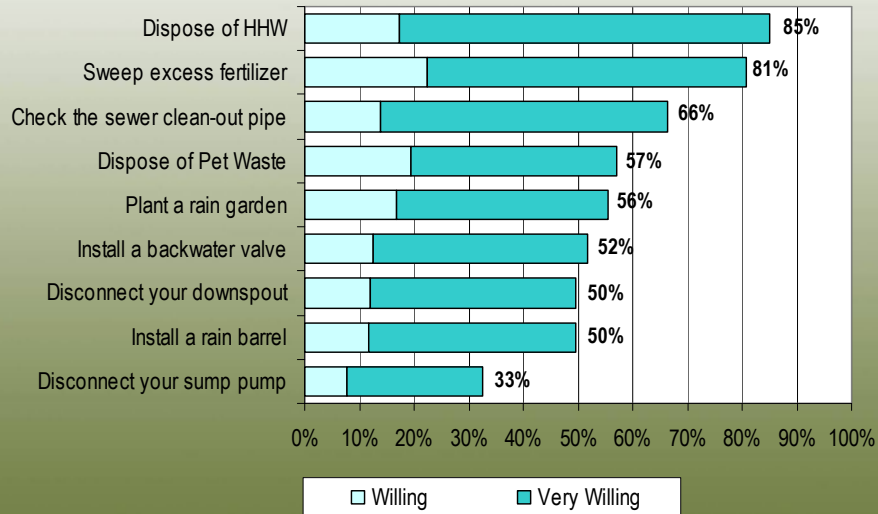
**Do You Think the City is On the Right Track with the Plans Proposed for Your Basin?**

by percentage of respondents City-wide

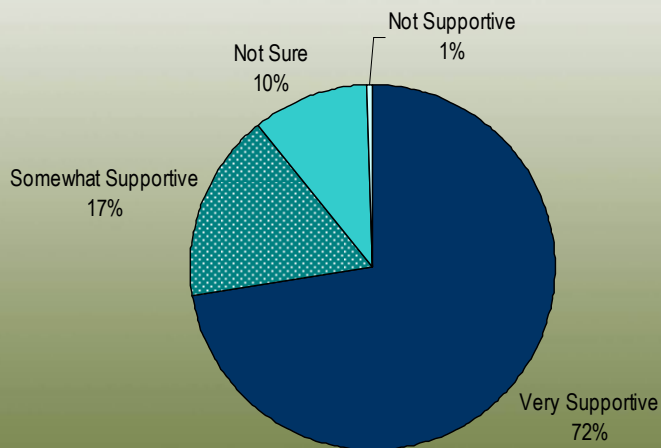


**Willingness of Residents to Do Things That Could Help Reduce Pollution of Streams and Lakes in Kansas City**

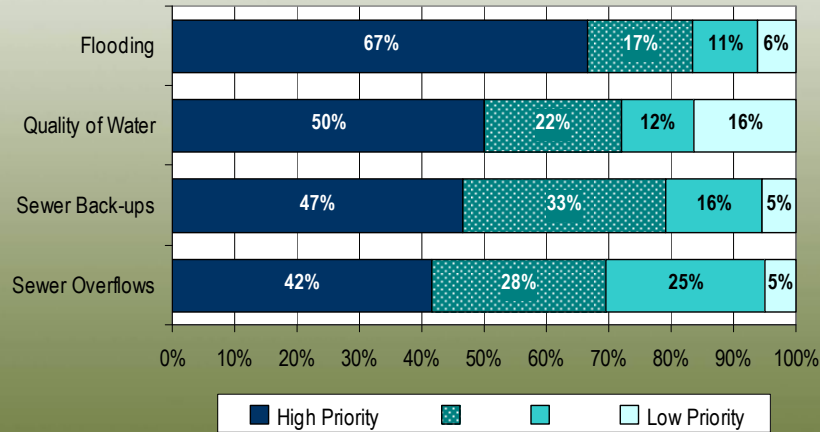
**How Supportive Would You Be of Adopting a Stream Setback Ordinance?**

### When Making Funding Decisions, How Do You Think City Leaders Should Prioritize the Following Issues?

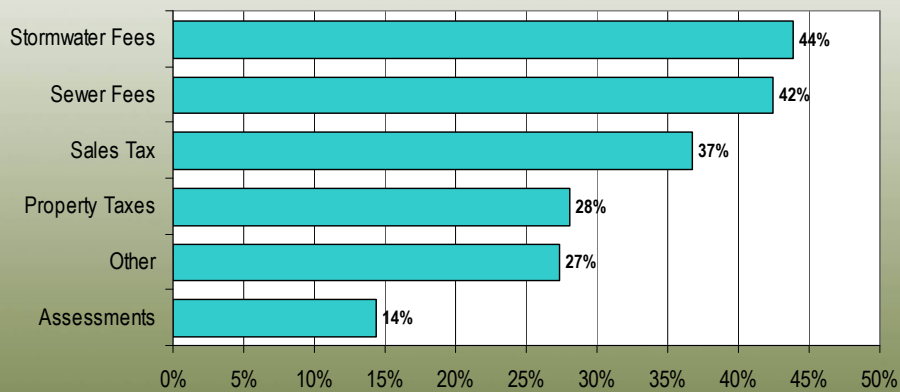
by percentage of respondents who rated the item as a 1 to 4 on a 4-point scale where a "1" is the highest priority

### What Sources of Funding Do You Think Would Be Appropriate Ways to Fund Improvements?

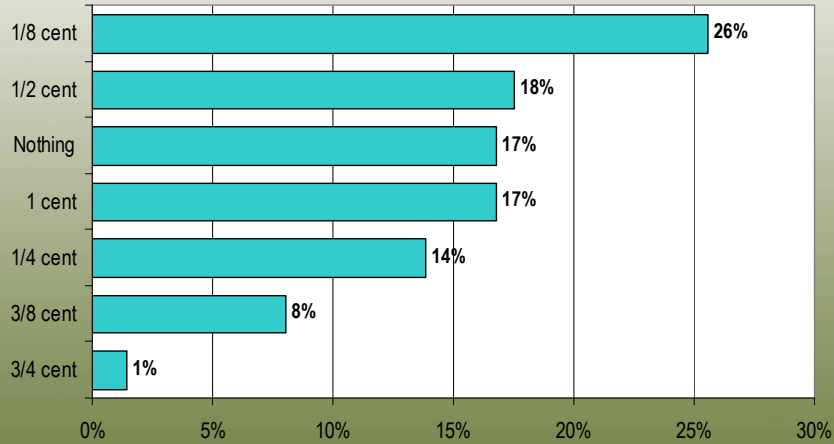
By percentage of respondents City-wide (multiple responses allowed)



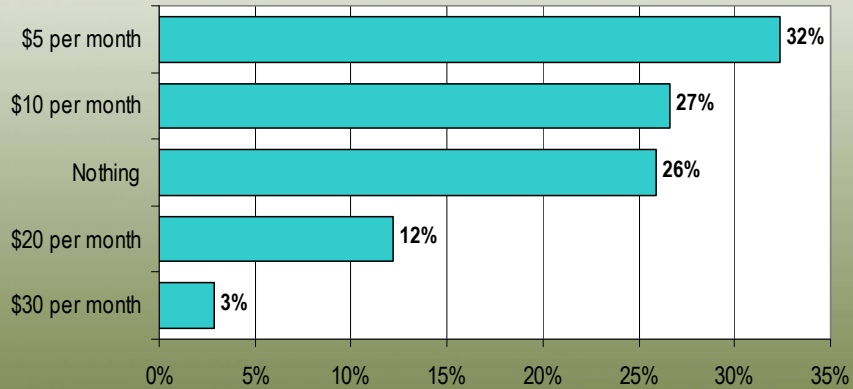
**"Other" Category responses primarily consisted of state and federal grants, bonds, and developer fees.**

by percentage of respondents City-wide

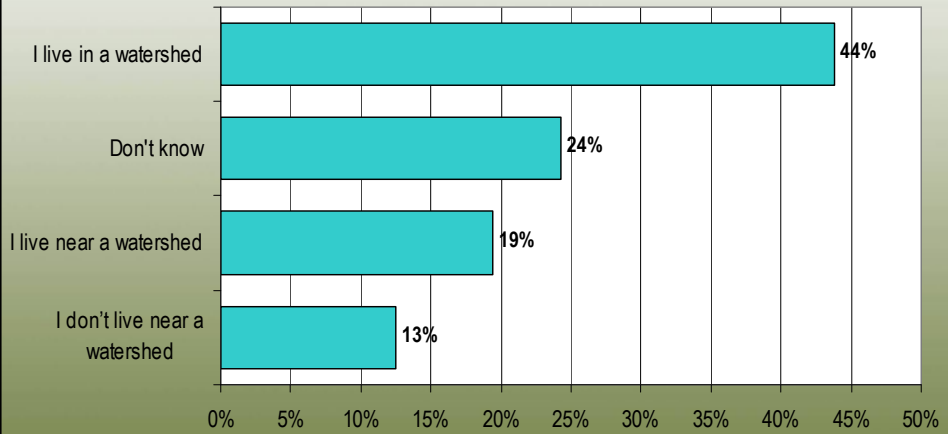


**What is the Maximum Increase in Utility Fees That You Would Support To Fund Improvements**
